Bus Engine Repowering – Greater Bridgeport Transit



Why it matters

This project includes the purchase and installation of repowered engines on 40 buses. This work is usually completed mid-life (after 300,000 miles) through a 12-year bus life expectancy.

Solid Investment

- This investment will assure the buses complete their normal lifespan while improving performance and reliability, reducing emissions, reducing maintenance costs, and assuring GBT buses are available to deliver the critical access to jobs, medical and educational opportunities, etc. that have a direct impact on economic development in the state.
- American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds allow the Project to proceed in a timely fashion.
